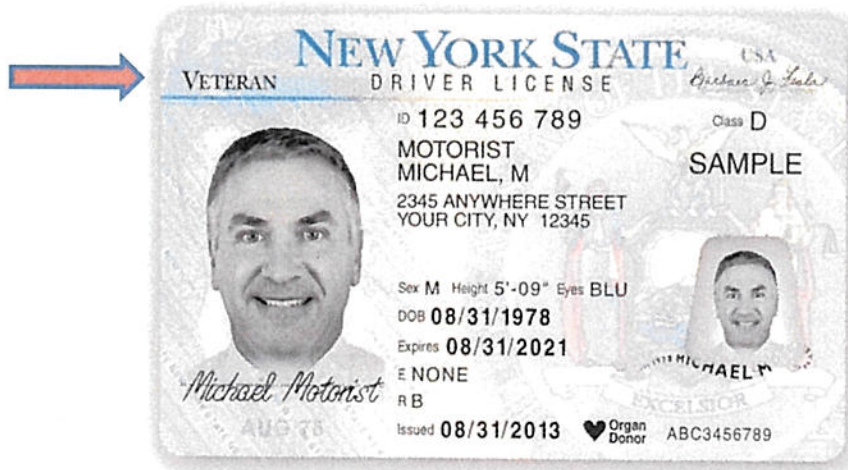
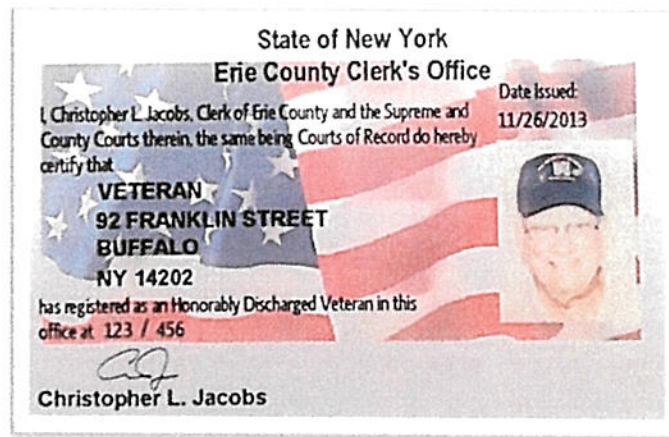

The State Department of Motor Vehicles has a veteran's status designation on driver's licenses, permits and non-driver identification cards for those honorably discharged from the United States Armed Forces. The word "VETERAN" is printed on the upper left hand corner of the license or identification card.
